

ASK US ABOUT **Early Intervention (EI)**



EI is a program for infants and toddlers younger than 3 years old who have developmental delays or are at risk of a developmental delay. EI:

- Supports families and caregivers.
- Helps infants and toddlers learn skills and develop independence.
- Uses personalized activities that fit into the child's and family's everyday life.

Any Massachusetts family with a child younger than 3 may be eligible for EI services if the child:

- Is not reaching expected milestones.
- Has certain conditions that may result in a developmental delay.
- Has a history that might put the child at risk for a delay.
