




Professional Development for EI Providers Update

Information on the Residential Assistance for Families in Transition (RAFT) Program

RAFT provides short-term financial assistance to low income families who are currently homeless or at risk for homelessness. The assistance can help with a family's particular needs (moving costs, rent or utilities arrears, utility bills, security deposits, etc.)

A family may qualify for up to \$4,000 in a 12 month period. A family can complete an intake at a Housing Consumer Education Center (HCEC) in their region. An assessment is made, and if approved, a RAFT application is completed.

MassHealth Provider Resource: Telephone and Internet Connectivity for Telehealth Lifeline Program - Subsidized Phone and Internet Service

Lifeline is a federal program that provides no cost or low-cost phone service to low-income households.

Eligibility based on income and public benefits, including Medicaid, SNAP, SSI, etc. (All MassHealth members are eligible.)

The <u>guidance document</u> produced by MassHealth and the Dept. of Telecommunications provides details on the Lifeline Program as well as information from various phone and internet providers on their response to COVID-19.

COVID-19 Resources in Other Languages
